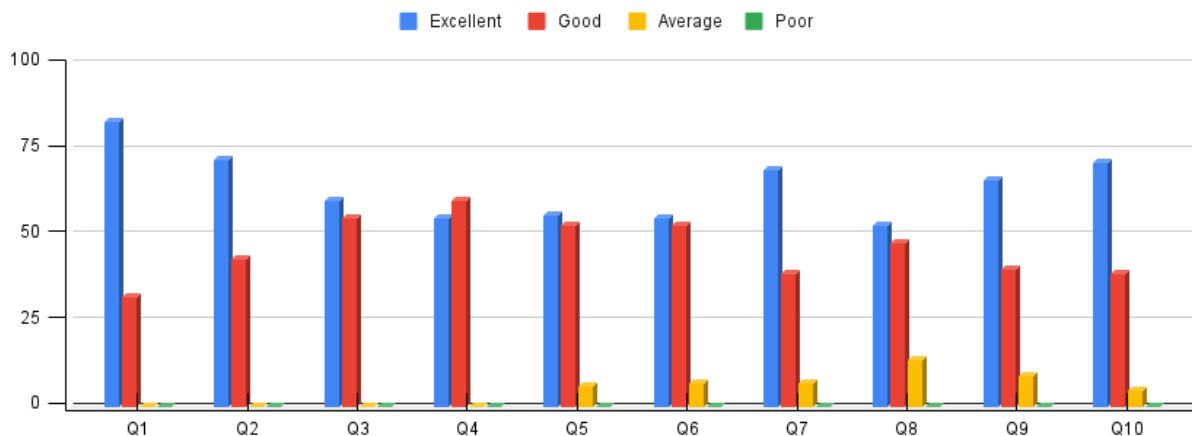

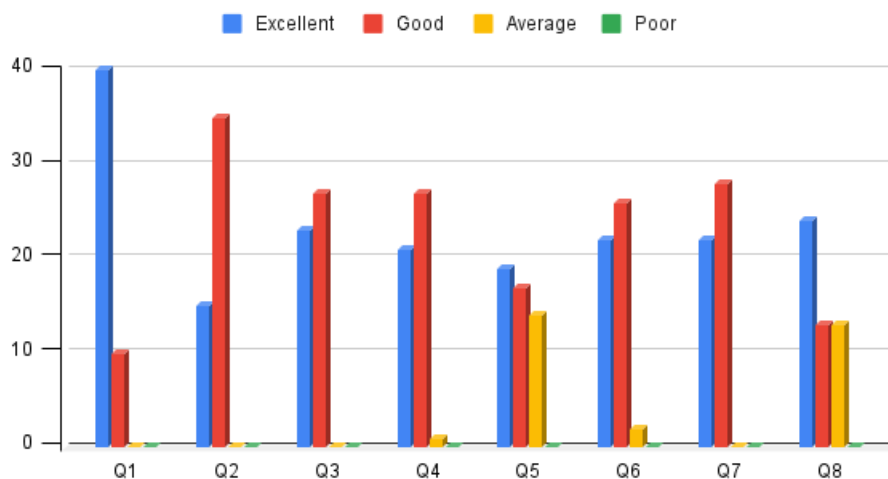

### Feedback on Curriculum by Alumni (2020-21)



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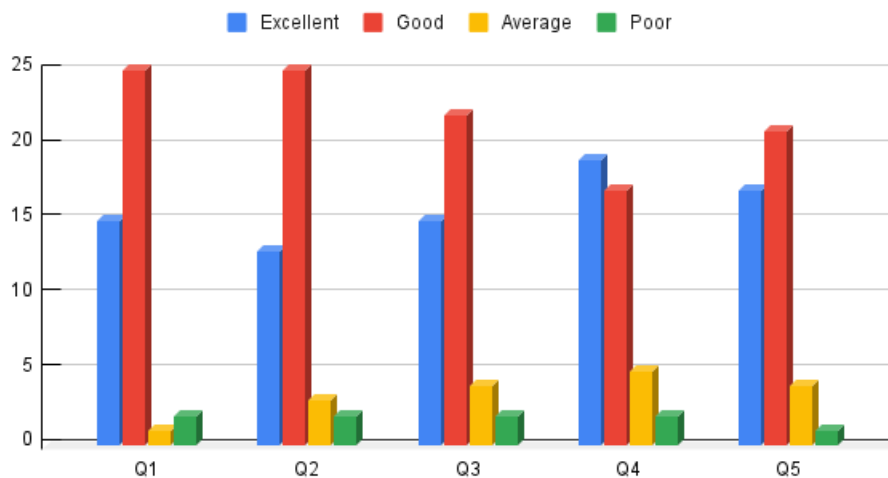

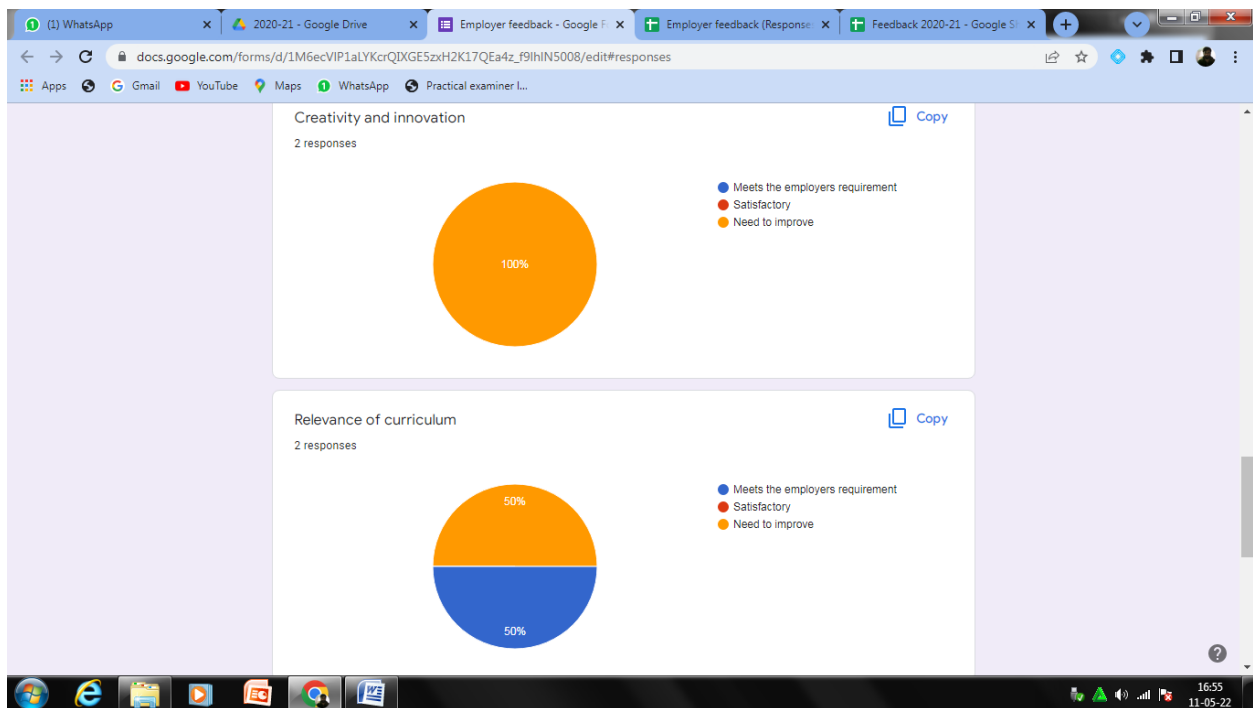

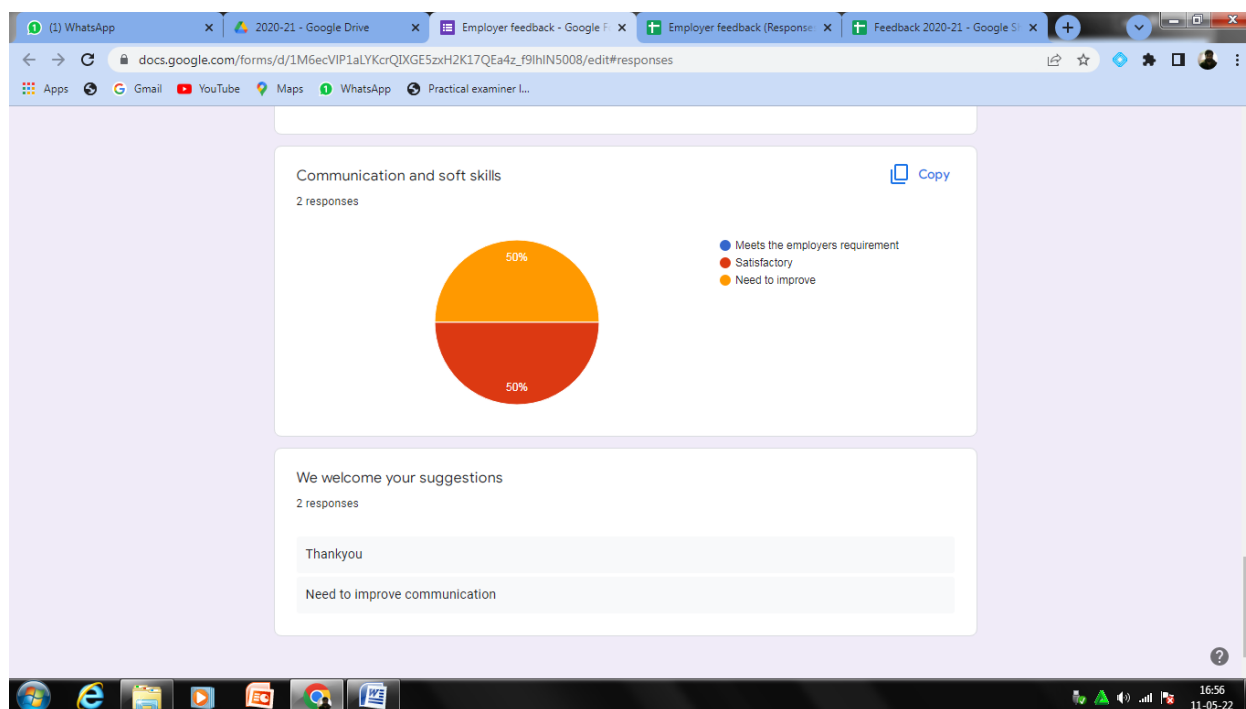
