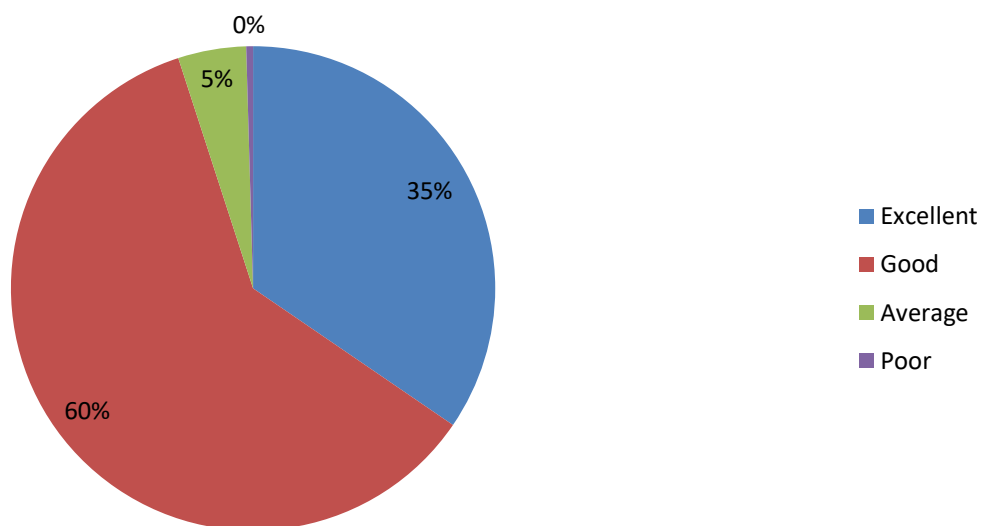

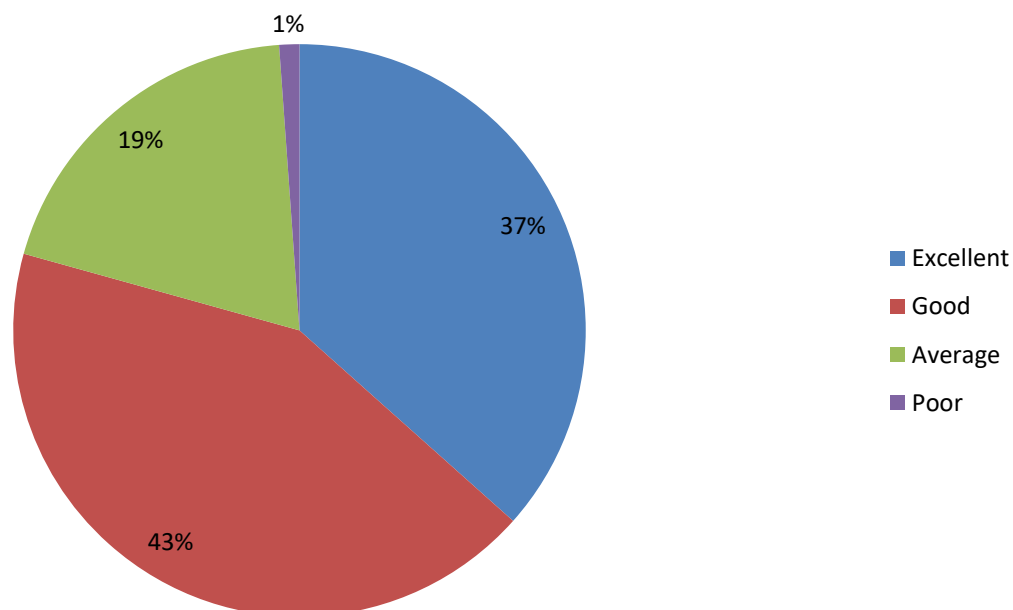

10.How do you rate the relevance of units in syllabus relevant to the course?



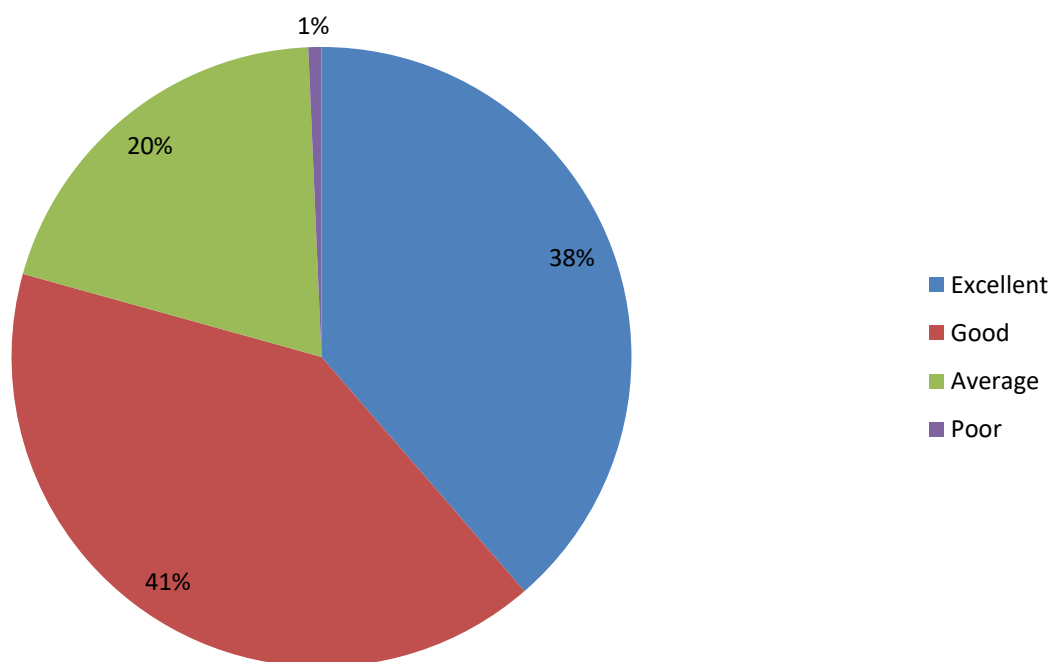

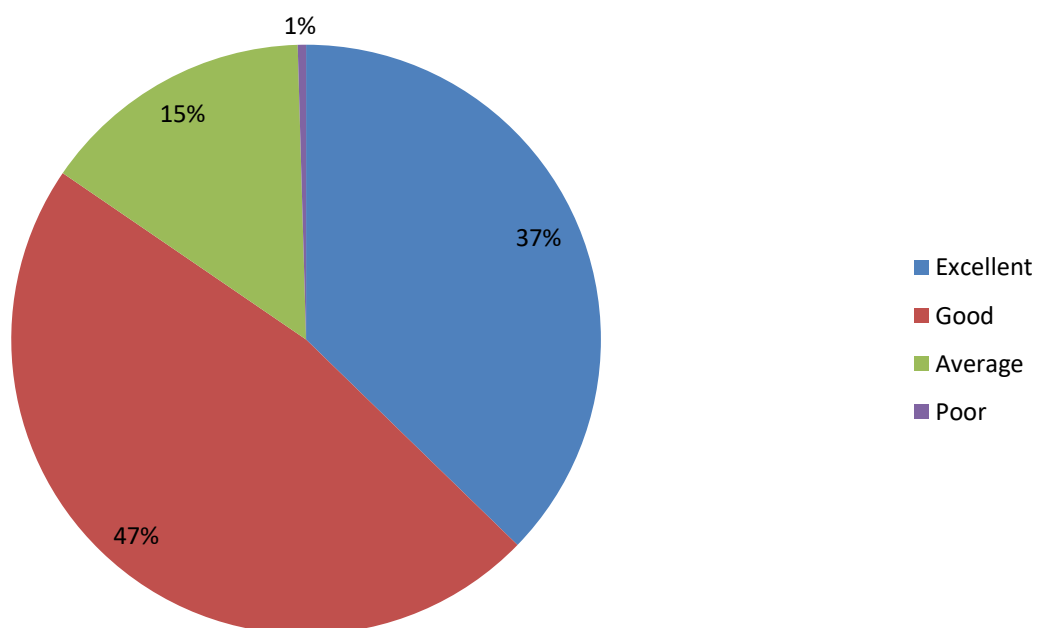

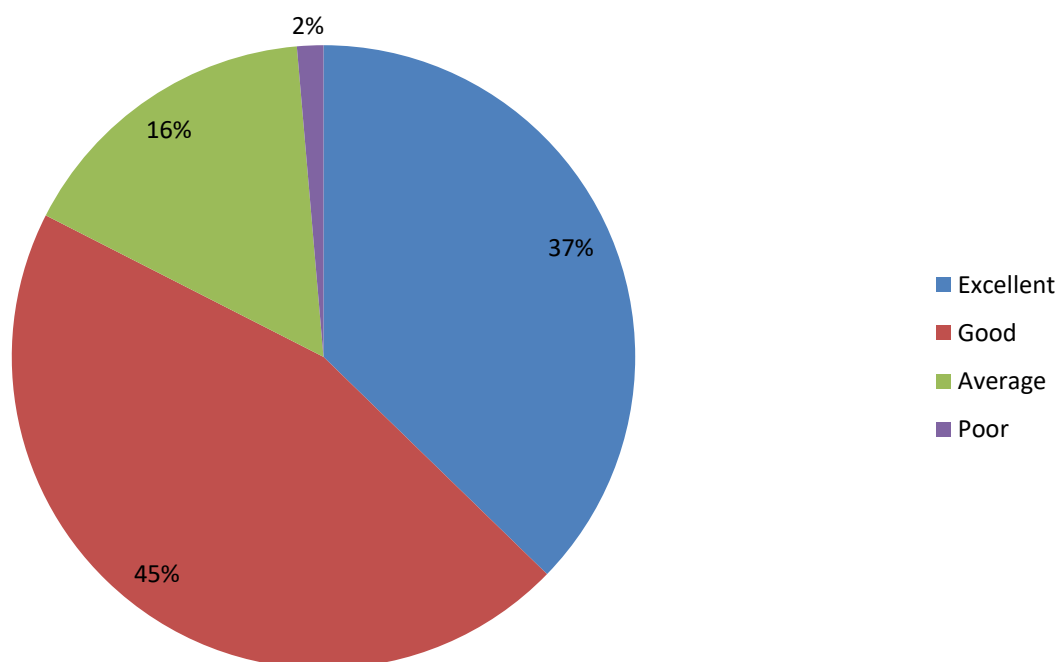

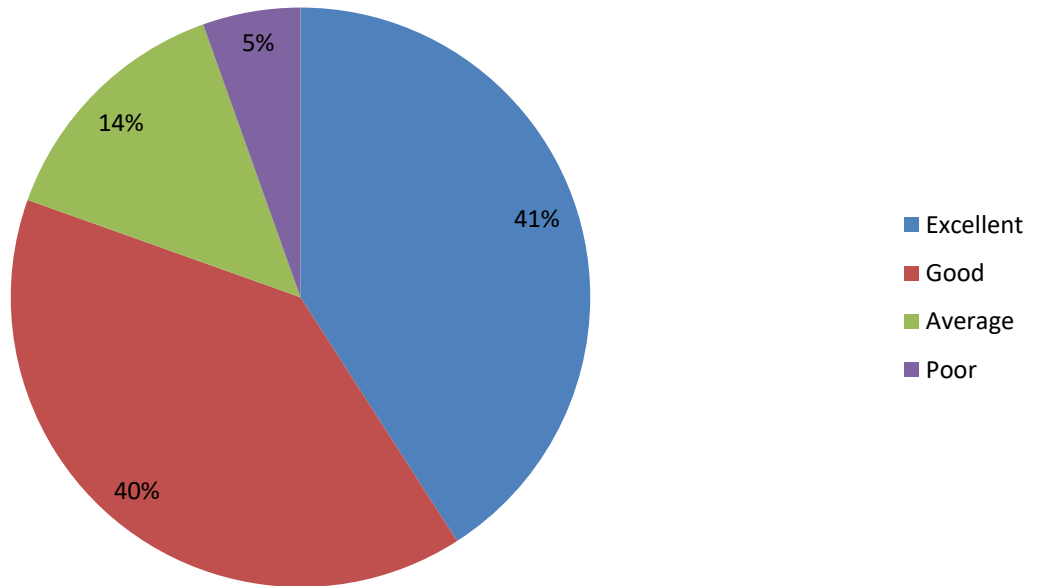

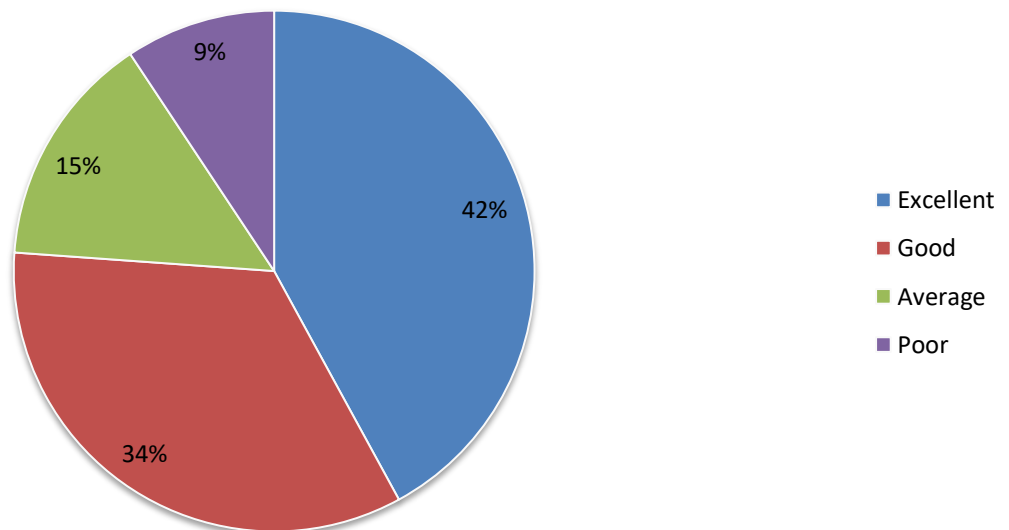

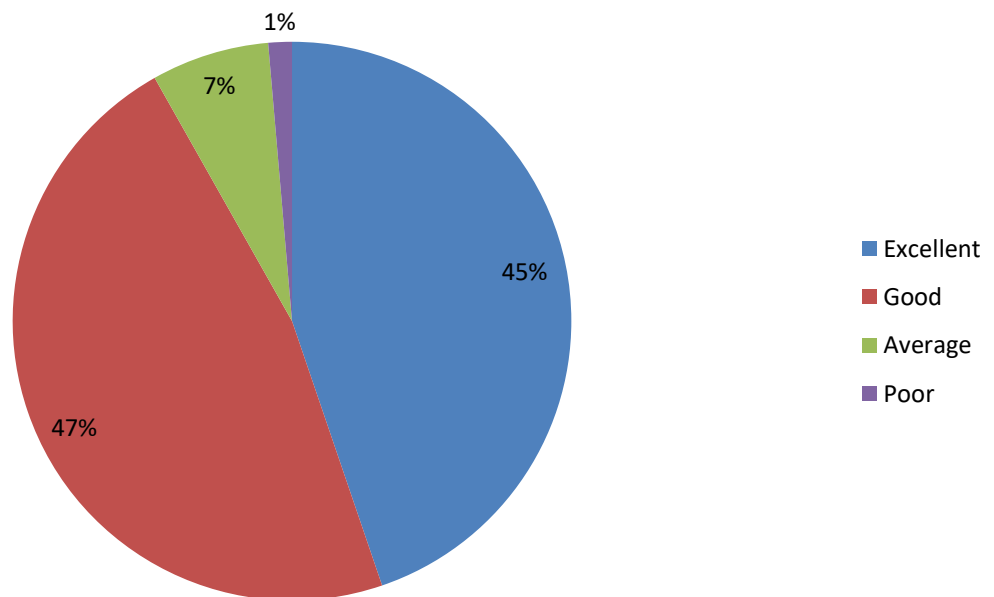

ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON OVERALL INSTITUTIONAL PERFORMANCE

Basing on the feedback obtained, it has been observed that, Students feedback has average ratings about:

- Presentation skills and usage of ICT tools by the teacher
- Conduct of student centric activities-Co-curricular/ Extra-curricular / Internship/Field Visits
- Rating the syllabus in terms of load on the students
- Curriculum relevant to real life applications and challenges
- Efforts made by the institute to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make the student ready for the world of work.

Students feedback has poor ratings about:

- Availability of safe drinking water
- Availability of washrooms

In response to the above, Principal and IQAC committee resolved the following:

- To conduct awareness programs on usage of ICT tools and to encourage the teachers to participate in online FDP programs on ICT tools and skill development to improve presentation skills.
- As CSP and Internship becomes mandatory and part of the curriculum, the sense of research attitude among the students will be improved.
- To organize Co and Extracurricular programs on all important events of the Department and Institution by providing list of events that each department could conduct in Academic calendar itself.
- To motivate students for internships.
- To organize field visits for experiential learning in relevant fields.
- To instruct the faculty to modify the syllabus in BOS meeting keeping time and knowledge of the students in focus.
- To conduct awareness on soft skills and life skills by eminent resource persons through seminars and workshops.
- To conduct certificate courses on employability skills.
- To instruct the students to utilize Purified R.O. drinking water only for drinking purposes, not to use it for washing their carrier boxes and not to waste.
- To use wash basins for cleaning purposes.
