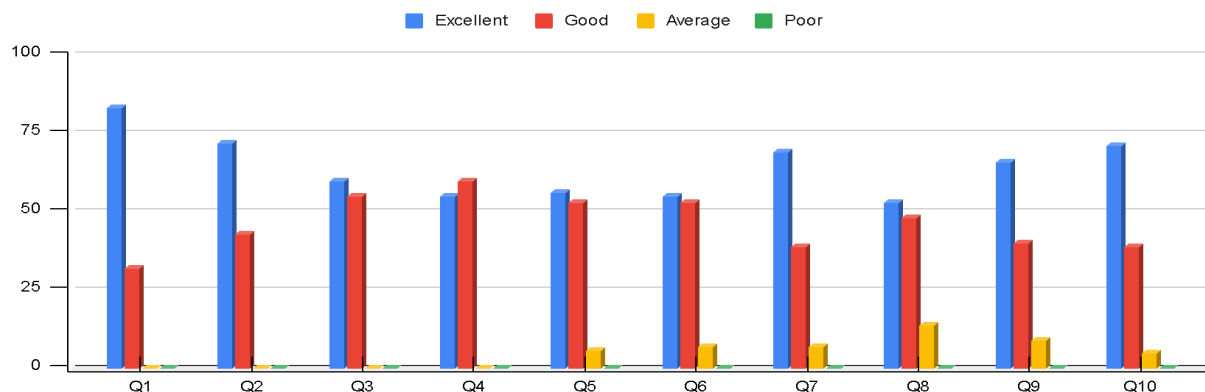

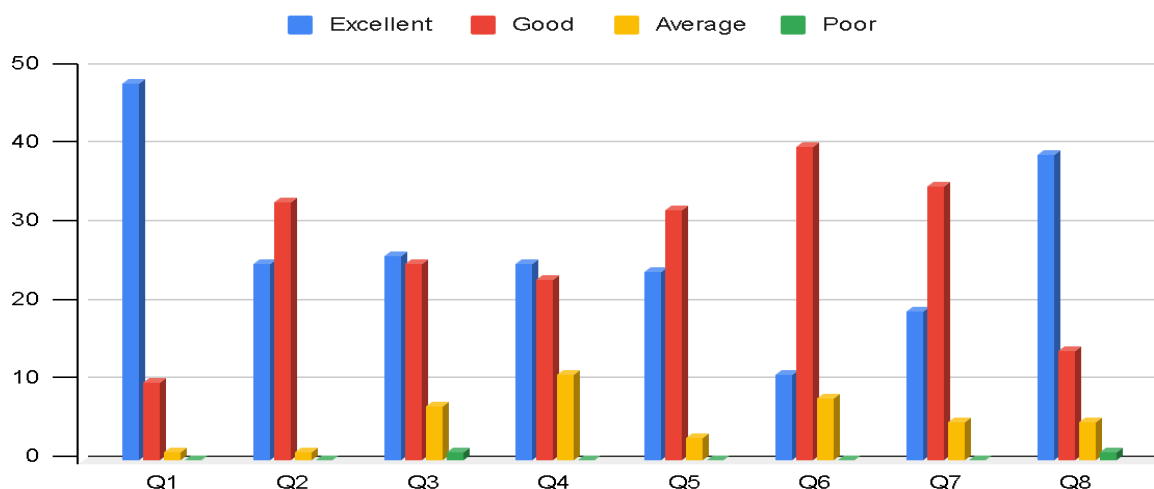
Feedback on Curriculum by Students (2021-22)

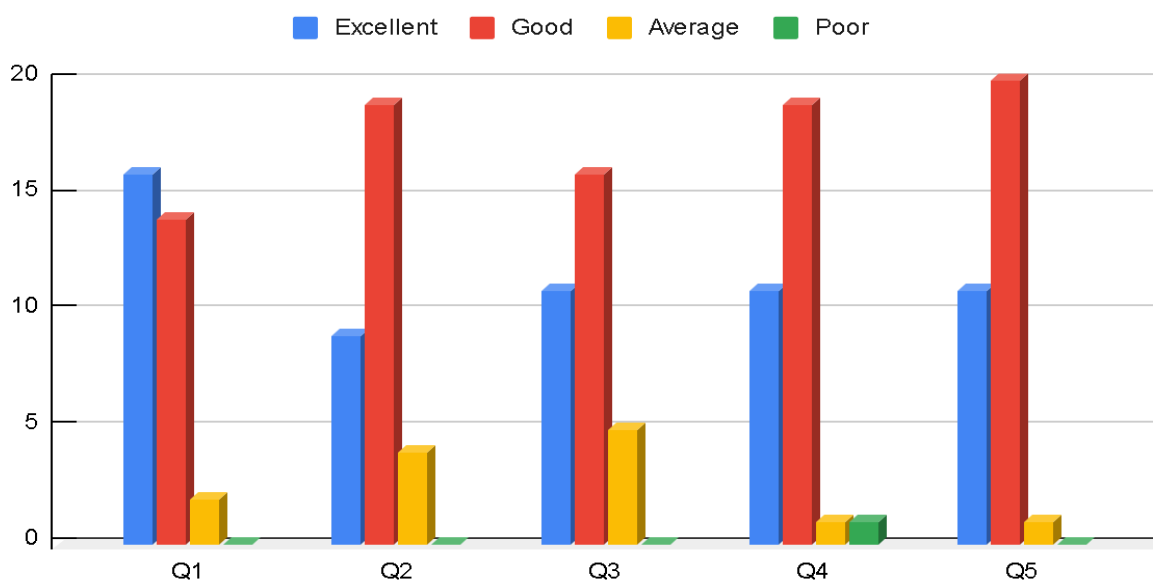
Feedback on Curriculum by Alumni (2021-22)
