I am pleased to inform you that you have been admitted for winter semester 2026 to the English taught master programme **International Food Business and Consumer Studies** at the University of Kassel. Both the admission and the language requirements are met. No further language certificates, such as an IELTS or a TOEFL certificate are required.

Please complete enrollment at eCampus (<https://ecampus.uni-kassel.de>). An eCampus account will be created for you for this purpose. The eCampus will be available for the winter semester from June 15, 2026. Please complete your enrolment by September 1 at the latest. The user ID corresponds to your e-mail address. You must reset your password once before logging in for the first time : www.uni-kassel.de/go/pw-reset . Please do not try to login earlier or to register/create an account yourself, as this will lead to technical problems later on. Detailed information on this process and all necessary steps you will find in the corresponding email.

Please note you can also change your postal address yourself in eCampus „My Studies > Online application > Personal Information“. If you have a problem concerning your enrollment, please do not hesitate to contact ["Information Studium"](#).

Please submit this letter to the embassy in charge in your country when applying for your student visa. Visa proceedings often take considerable time, so an early visa application is recommended to ensure you arrive in time. The winter semester 2026 starts October 1, 2026. The events start with the welcome week **in October 2026**, so please make sure you are on site then taking as well into consideration that you need to organize necessary administration issues before events start.

Attention: Your admission is only valid for **the semester as stated above**. If you want your application to be re-considered for the next application period, please send an e-mail to master@uni-kassel.de. The deadline is **November 1, 2026**. Otherwise you will need to re-apply via uni assist.

- The master programme International Food Business and Consumer Studies is a joint degree programme offered from the University of Kassel (Faculty of Organic Agricultural Sciences, Witzenhausen campus) and Fulda University of Applied Sciences (Faculty of Nutritional, Food and Consumer Sciences, Fulda campus). The administration is with the University of Kassel, lectures are offered at both campuses in Witzenhausen and Fulda. In general, one or two days per week you study at Fulda campus and 3-4 days you study at Witzenhausen campus. The ticket for public transport is included in the semester ticket that is covered by the administration fee for Kassel University. Please note that the Faculty of Organic Agricultural Sciences of the University of Kassel is located in Witzenhausen, which is 40 km from Kassel.
