FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2025-2026

The Principal and the members of IQAC committee held a meeting on 13.04.2026 to analyze the feedback given by the stakeholders about course curriculum and take necessary actions.

General analysis of Feedback on curriculum in terms of percentage

1. It has been observed that, the students are comparatively less satisfactory for the following questionnaire

- Coverage of modern/advanced topics
- Size of the syllabus in terms of load of the student
- Courses learnt in relation to real life applications

2. Teachers have given only 53% excellent to 'course/syllabus increased knowledge and perspective in the subject area'.

3. Alumni have given below 60% excellent to 'benefits derived from the course'.

In response to the above, Principal and IQAC committee decided to

- Conduct more add-on / certificate courses to inculcate job oriented skills among students
- Conduct more campus / placement drives
- Regarding the size of syllabus – the feedback analysis report is sent to Registrar of Cluster university, Kurnool
- Conduct project works for improving creativity and innovation
